Are you passionate about making a difference in education through professional learning? Do you have expertise in and knowledge of significant research and trends in education and learning? Are you searching for an opportunity that would draw upon your creativity, leadership, and instructional coaching abilities?

The Calgary Regional Consortium (CRC) is seeking a Designer of Professional Learning to design and facilitate professional learning opportunities for educators in ***K-3 or K-6 mathematics for up to 30 days.***

These learning opportunities would support teachers in developing innovative, inclusive, and effective approaches to learning math.

Main Responsibilities

- Designing and/or delivering interactive math sessions on content and pedagogy using research based strategies that teachers could then implement in their own context
- Fostering and maintaining school authority relationships
- Supporting Implementation Planning and Reporting in collaboration with other DPLs
- Collaborating with other Designers of Professional Learning when requested by the Executive Director
- Reporting to the Executive Director on session feedback, participant involvement and ideas for potential next steps

Key Qualifications

Duties will commence in Fall 2022 and continue throughout the 2022-23 school year on an “as needed” basis for up to 30 days. The successful candidate (s) will possess the following experience, knowledge, and abilities:

- Valid Alberta teaching certification
- 7+ years of experience teaching math at the grade range of interest (K-3 or K-6)

- Experience designing, facilitating, and organizing teacher professional learning
- Understanding of current research and demonstrated expertise in mathematics
- Understanding of the Alberta Program of Studies, the Ministerial Order on Student Learning and related education initiatives
- Proven organizational skills, including handling of multiple details
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Superior computer skills (able to create and share digital session materials, able to present in person or online)
- Flexibility in scheduling work to accommodate the timing of learning opportunities, which may include days, after-school or early evenings
- Flexibility with changing priorities and the ability to handle multiple tasks with short deadlines
- Ability to regularly travel to schools & districts within Zone 5 (e.g. Calgary, Hanna, Airdire, High River, Strathmore, Canmore etc.).

CRC offers a competitive salary, travel reimbursement (within Zone 5), flexible work schedule and hybrid work model.
