By joining any or all of these on-line supports, teachers can expect to:

- Find supportive networks of provincial colleagues to 'think together with' as they develop innovative and engaging learning solutions that best support every student.
- Participate in positive conversations about supporting both synchronous & asynchronous learning using hightech and no-tech methods.
- Gain insights in to how other educators are supporting student diversity and student mental wellness during these trying times.
- Participate in the provincial sharing of ideas to support learning from home focused on developing language/literacy and math/numeracy in the early years, as well as social and science in the older years as per Ministry guidelines.
